# Pupil Premium

## WHAT IS IT?

- Extra money the school receives to support children's learning and wellbeing.
- It can pay for things like: extra teaching support, small group work, help with trips/clubs, and resources to boost learning.

## COULD YOUR CHILD BE ELIGIBLE FOR EXTRA FUNDING?

- One quick check could unlock up to £1,515 per year for our school via the Pupil Premium



## HOW TO APPLY

1. Check if you qualify on the Hampshire website.
2. Complete the short online form.
3. Tell us if your child is adopted/under SGO/CAO, or if you're a service family.

Prefer help? Pop into the school office—applications are quick and confidential.

## WHY APPLY?

- Children in Reception–Year 2 still get Universal Free School Meals, and applying unlocks extra funding for the school.
- It's confidential and does not affect your other benefits.
- It helps us provide more support, clubs, enrichment and resources for all pupils.

## WHO CAN APPLY?

- Families receiving qualifying benefits, e.g. Universal Credit (household income under £7,400 after tax, not including benefits), Income Support, Income-based JSA, Income-related ESA, Child Tax Credit (no Working Tax Credit, income below £16,190), the guaranteed element of Pension Credit, or support under the Immigration & Asylum Act.
- Children adopted from care or under a Special Guardianship/Child Arrangement Order – please tell the school (this helps us claim Pupil Premium Plus).
- Armed Forces families (currently serving or in the last 6 years) – let us know for the Service Pupil Premium.
